

VKORC1: Normal warfarin sensitivity

What is VKORC1?

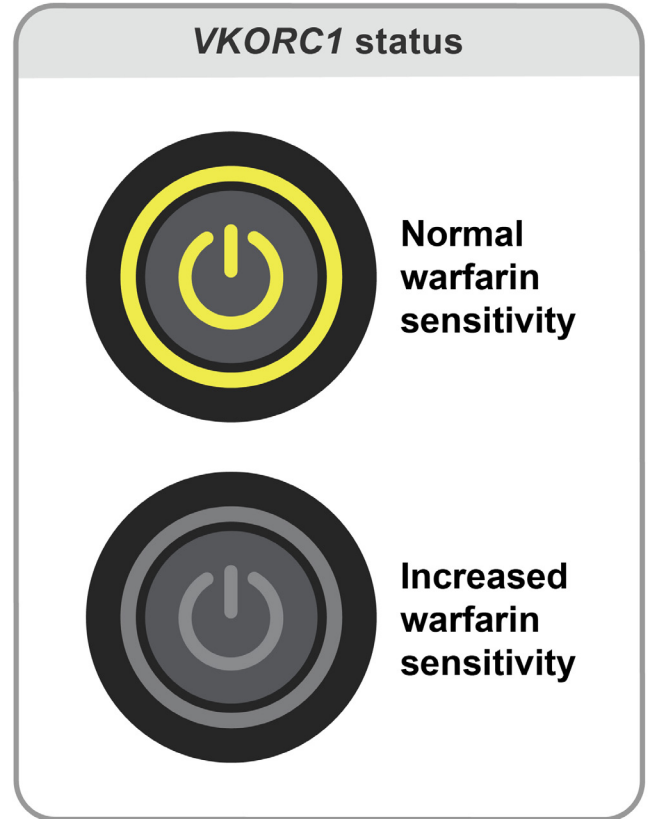
VKORC1 is a gene that provides instructions for making the VKORC1 enzyme, which plays a key role in blood clotting.

VKORC1 status: Normal warfarin sensitivity

These pharmacogenetic results predicted likely **normal sensitivity to warfarin**.

The health-care team will likely prescribe the **average dose of warfarin**.

This status is not an indicator of health. The health-care team will still consider medical history and other factors to ensure the best treatment.



Example medications affected by VKORC1

- **Warfarin**, an anticoagulant medication that helps prevent blood clotting
